All campers may also elect to use a payment plan to pay for the camp fees. Be sure to complete the Payment plan/Financial Assistance form and enclose it with your application. Cancellations less than 2 weeks before camp starts will result in forfeiture of all camp fees. For cancellations more than 2 weeks before camp, fees paid will be refunded less a \$50 handling charge.
